The warp beam produced by the new machine is much wider and longer than previous models of the series. Mini Lutan 1700 is a comprehensive warping machine which not only can perfectly work with sampling loom, but also can be used directly on production loom and finishing equipment. Taroko's Two-spindle Option Gives Greater Flexibility

Modular design is one of the biggest features of Taroko. In addition to the existing solution of 4 spindles as a module, the machine now has a two-spindle option to support our new product, Mini Lutan 1700. The option gives greater flexibility to fulfill customer's demands for small amounts of sizing. The high system configuration flexibility of Taroko is capable of meeting the needs of various applications.

Besides, Taroko is fully computer controlled which allows user to proceed the whole sizing process with ease. Its machine size is greatly reduced, and it can be operated with a minimum of one yarn bobbin, considerably saving space, manpower & energy costs.



World Festival in 2019

Kebalan & Sea Festival (LaLiGi) (April)

The Kebalan is part of the larger Taiwanese aborigine ethnic group. Their people have strong ethnic consciousness and the most distinctive cultural among the Pingpu ethnic groups in Taiwan. The Kebalan



people were the first indigenous people to live in the Lanyang Plain in Yilan County, thus contributed to the development of the area. The name was also used as the origin of the place name of "Yilan" County today. The Sea Festival (LaLiGi) is the largest festival of the Kebalan. It is around mid-April, the beginning of the fishing season. On the day of the festival, people will worship the sea gods and pray for peace and harvest.
